- Willing to work long hours and split shifts as needed
- Commitment to spring & summer plant (May 1 to August 10)

fridges and freezers are set up outside of the cook trailer and there is an animal-proof dry storage unit for each camp.

- A very proactive approach to safety and injury prevention. Onsite OFA Level 3 attendants who are trained specifically in tree planting related injury prevention.
- Planters work a 3 day on, 1 day off, shift rotation. These non-production days will be used to prep for the next shift of work, but cooks are encouraged to work on a rotating schedule so that each person may have 1 day off every 5-7 days.
- Camp costs are paid by all employees however, culinary staff have a reduced rate of \$10.00 per planting day.
